

CMHWF FAQs

Can I apply for the funding next year if not successful this year?

Yes. But you will have to meet the usual criteria

Can I apply for funding this year if my organisation is currently receiving the 2-yr grant?

No, you will not be eligible to apply

Can I put one application in for a Clacks Project and a sperate one in for a Stirling Project?

No, you can only submit one application per organisation

Can I apply for less than £4,000?

Yes, you can apply for any amount up to £4,000

How many years can I apply for the CMHWF?

The fund can support both existing and new projects. Projects funded during the first five years of the fund may apply again but must demonstrate how they will develop, improve, and achieve new outcomes in Years 6 and 7, including evidence of previous impact where possible.

This funding is not intended to provide core funding. Repeat applicants must show significant progression from previous funding, with new activities or outcomes. While repeat applications are welcome, priority will be given to new groups and organisations that have not previously received funding through the programme.

How will the applications be assessed?

Panel members will score the Full applications and then meet in person to make final decisions. Panel will look at how the project meets the criteria of the fund as well as local strategic plans, value for money, impact, participant numbers etc
