Why did this Manifesto come about?



 TSI Scotland Network formed voluntarily by Chief Officers in early 2019

 TSI Scotland Network launched at SCVO's Gathering in February 2020

 Pandemic – monthly meetings and regional groups started – shared learning and survey led to Manifesto

What did the survey tell us?




 Half of all organisations had changed or modified what they did

 Clear 'community' had flourished and risen to challenges of supporting each other

 Reduction in fundraising critical for future of many organisations
